Dear Parent,

I hope that you and your family are all keeping well.

The last two weeks has seen a successful re-phased opening of Dafen School for the 'Check in, Catch up, prepare for summer and September' sessions. It has been wonderful to see and hear children back in school. However I also appreciate and understand parents' uncertainty about sending their children back to school during this period.

The Welsh Minister for Education announced last week that schools in Wales will re-open for all pupils in September. At the present time I have no further information that I can share with you as the guidelines have not yet been published. When the information becomes available I will inform you of the arrangements for the 'return to school in September'.

Please find attached a letter from Carmarthenshire County Council's Director of Education with regards to schools opening in September.

Please note the following information:

**Home Learning** – There will be no additional home learning activities uploaded into the pupil's J2e / Google Classroom files during this last week of term. Pupils to take this opportunity to undertake any work that has not been completed. Also please refer to the Home Learning Activities on the school web-site.

**End of Year Reports** - Children who are in school during this week will receive their school report from their class teacher. For all other pupils - parents are welcome to collect their child's report from the Main School entrance on the following days and times:

Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July: Foundation Phase Pupils, 10am – 11am  
Key Stage 2 Pupils, 11.30am – 12.30pm

Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July: Key Stage 2 Pupils, 10am – 11am  
Foundation Phase Pupils, 11.30am – 12.30pm

Please note that the reports will only be available for collection during these days and times. If you are collecting your child's report, please adhere to social distancing guidelines.

If you are unable to collect your child's school report, the report will be kept safely in school until September when the children return to school.

If you are aware of any parent who has not subscribed to Schoop would you please forward this information to them.

I look forward to welcoming all of the children back to school in September.
